Faena Hotel Miami Beach is the go-to hotel for an over-the-top Miami experience. Set on a gorgeous stretch of beach, each of the 169 rooms suites, and 13 penthouse residences feature an artful visual language that recalls the glamour of the 1950s with stunning Art Deco appeal. The 4,515 sq. ft. Faena Suite showcases panoramic turquoise ocean views through floor to ceiling windows. Envisioned by Alan Faena, the design features a color palette of red and blues alongside lush velvet and bold prints. The suite is complete with four bedrooms, four full bathrooms, two half-bathrooms, furnished oceanfront balconies, a full kitchen, and an elegant living room. Additionally, Faena Hotel Miami Beach in exclusive partnership with Red Bull, will be the official Red Bull Guest House for Miami's Formula 1 Grand Prix from May 5 - 9 2022. Lanai Oceanfront King Suite at The Ritz-Carlton, South Beach

The suite boasts four bedrooms and four bathrooms as well as state-of-the-art technology including a wall-mounted 50-inch flat screen TV in each living room and bedroom and a tablet that controls temperature, lighting, shades, and music.
